### TOP 10 NATIVE PLANTS TO ATTRACT RUBY-THROATED HUMMINGBIRDS

Plants that attract wildlife • Plants with bright red and orange flowers

| 1  | Cardinal flower<br>( <i>Lobelia cardinalis</i> )      | 3 ft.     | Sun/<br>pt. shade   | Ideal for rain gardens                         |
| 2  | Copper iris ( <i>Iris fulva</i> )                     | 2 ft.     | Full sun            | Groundcover, rain gardens                      |
| 3  | Coral honeysuckle<br>( <i>Lonicera sempervirens</i> ) | 8–12 ft.  | Sun                 | Small-scale, clump-forming vine                |
| 4  | Crossvine<br>( <i>Bignonia capreolata</i> )           | >30 ft.   | Sun/shade           | Grows up mature trees,<br>blooms in treetops   |
| 5  | Indian pink<br>( <i>Spigelia marylandica</i> )        | 1–2 ft.   | Shade/<br>pt. shade | Small-scale, clump-forming                     |
| 6  | Jewelweed<br>( <i>Impatiens capensis</i> )            | 3–5 ft.   | Sun/<br>pt. shade   | Weedy annual, seeds pop,<br>children enjoy     |
| 7  | Red buckeye<br>( <i>Aesculus pavia</i> )              | 10–15 ft. | Sun/<br>pt. shade   | Small-scale tree,<br>looses leaves early       |
| 8  | Royal catchfly<br>( <i>Silene regia</i> )             | 3–4 ft.   | Sun/<br>pt. shade   | Requires good drainage,<br>summer bloomer      |
| 9  | Trumpet creeper<br>( <i>Campsis radicans</i> )        | >30 ft.   | Sun/<br>pt. shade   | Aggressive suckering,<br>isolate with lawn     |
| 10 | Wild columbine<br>( <i>Aquilegia canadensis</i> )     | 2 ft      | Shade/<br>pt. shade | Tolerant of dry-avg. soil and<br>rock crevices |
