Winter Interest • Long Lived • Winter Seeds That Attract Birds

	NATIVE PLANT NAME	HEIGHT	UNIQUE WINTER QUALITY
1	Purple daisy (<i>Symphyotrichum (Aster) patens</i>)	18–24"	Tan fluffy seeds early winter.
2	Texas green eyes (<i>Berlandiera texana</i>)	36–48"	Finches favorite. Seeds quickly eaten.
3	Downy pagoda-plant (<i>Blephilia ciliata</i>)	12–18"	Tiered seed heads showy.
4	False boneset (<i>Brickelia eupatorioides</i>)	24–36"	Showy silver seeds hold on tight in winter.
5	Eastern Blazingstar (<i>Liatris scariosa</i>)	36–48"	Best winter seed quantity. Large seeds.
6	Bradbury beebalm (<i>Monarda bradburiana</i>)	12–18"	Snow stacks on flat seed heads.
7	Wild basil (<i>Pycnanthemum virginicum</i>)	30–36"	Bright grey heads showy. Good winter seed.
8	Switchgrass (<i>Panicum virgatum</i>)	24–48"	Showy in winter. Holds on tight to seed.
9	Orange coneflower (<i>Rudbeckia fulgida</i>)	18–24"	Showy dark brown heads hold on to seeds.
10	Cliff goldenrod (<i>Solidago drummondii</i>)	18–24"	White fluffy seeds early winter.
